

What do you suggest for a Time Capsule submission?

Great question! Your best guide is to consider submitting something that could have nostalgic or historical value 25 years from now. Here are some idea starters:

- Write a Letter!

You can write to your 'future' self, a friend, a future relative – or anyone at all! Talk about your favorite memories of Milford, what life is like in 2014, or what you hope to accomplish in the future. It is entirely up to you.



- **Posters.** Draw a picture of your favorite place in Milford. With so many picturesque spots in our city – that should be easy to do!



(posters cannot be larger than 18" x 24").

- Photographs.

With the hundreds of beautiful places in Milford to visit – it should be easy to take some wonderful photographs of 2014 Milford.

- **Recordings.** Talk away! Interview a friend or neighbor who has lived in Milford for a long time. Visit the Senior Citizen center to conduct an oral history with the patrons there.

Submissions will be reviewed and sorted by the Time Capsule Committee. Please note that all submissions will not be included in the Time Capsule, due to size limits. All submissions become the property of the City of Milford.
